Elgin Avenue Improvement Project Overview:

The project aims to enhance road safety and improve traffic flow on Elgin Avenue and surrounding areas. It will entail:

- Widening Elgin Avenue from its current two lanes to three and four, including a centre turning lane.
- Widening Humber Lane to accommodate increased traffic flow.
- Establishing a mini roundabout at the intersection of Elgin Avenue and Hospital Road

- Establishing a pedestrian crossing near the new Government Administration Building
- Reconstructing sidewalks to provide a continuous walkway along Elgin Avenue (from the Hospital Road roundabout to the CNB roundabout).
- Sidewalks will be fitted with ramps and driveways for the disabled.
- Improving drainage to reduce Elgin Avenue flooding.

Work begins September 2010 and completion by February 2011 is expected. In an effort to minimise disruption to motorists, as much as possible, the majority of work will be done at night.
