The last remaining vehicle, a Ford Taurus bearing no license plate and parked just beside the "No Parking" sign, was towed away today (Thursday, 26 July) at 10:00 a.m.

National Roads Authority (NRA) Transportation Planner Marion Pandohie said that prior to the towing the owner was contacted on three separate occasions regarding removal of the vehicle. But, with no response the NRA decided to remove the vehicle themselves.

She added, "Going forward we are going to be keeping a close eye on that area."

To retrieve vehicles that are towed, owners should contact the NRA main office at <u>946-7780</u> and pay a \$200 towing fee.
