



What is a school zone?

A school zone is an essential safety feature at our schools.

It is designed to:

- · Slow down traffic;
- · Allow students to be safely dropped off and picked-up;

A school zone begins at the School Speed 15 MPH when Flashing sign and ends at the End School Zone sign.

Tips for the road:

- Be aware of all school zones, keep your eyes on the road and your mind on the task at hand at all times.

 Follow the speed limit and SLOW DOWN to 15mph in designated school zones when the light is flashing.
